## AN EASEMENT

## FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, AND MAINTENANCE OF A WATER MAIN and PRESSURE REDUCING VALVE

This EASEMENT, executed this 16 day of December, 2001, for the construction, operation, and maintenance of a water main and pressure reducing valve with appurtenances, by The Calera Water Works Board, hereinafter called the OWMER across the property of the LANDOWNER, Peggie Killingsworth as shown on the attached sketch, is granted by the LANDOWNER to the OWNER for valuable considerations, the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged by the LANDOWNER, for himself, and his heirs, executors, successors, and assigns.

One permanent easement, to go with the land to allow the OWNER, its employees and agents to construct, operate, repair, and maintain the OWNER'S water main and pressure reducing valve including the right of access by the OWNER, its employees and agents, or officials, and necessary related equipment. Included is the right to uncover the water main and pressure reducing valve, with the obligation to leave the LANDOWNER'S property in good repair after completion of any repair to the water main. Water Board agreers to 1-1" Tap + 1-34 to 1" upgrade. M
