

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF INSTALLTILE.COM, LLC

Pursuant to the Provisions of the Code of Alabama, Title 10, Chapter 12, Article 1, et. seq., the undersigned hereby adopt the following limited liability company Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE I

The name of the limited liability company is: InstallTile.com, LLC (hereinafter referred to as the "Company").

ARTICLE II

The period of duration for the Company is perpetual, beginning from the date these Articles of Organization are filed in the Office of the Judge of Probate of the county in which the initial registered office of the Company is located.

ARTICLE III

The purpose or purposes for which the Company is organized is the transaction of any and all lawful business for which limited liability companies may be organized under the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act, including, but not limited to, any and all transactions which are necessary, appropriate or incidental to the sale and installation of residential or commercial flooring, counter tops, and wall coverings as associated with the renovation of existing, or the construction of new, residential or commercial buildings.

ARTICLE IV

The location and street address of the initial registered office of the Company is 118 Whitney Circle, Vincent, Alabama 35178, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Andrew C. Gannett.

Additional members may be admitted by the unanimous vote of existing members of the Company.


ARTICLE VII

Upon the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy, dissolution, or dissociation of a member, or the occurrence of any other event which terminates the continued membership of a member in the Company, the business of the Company shall not be continued and the Company shall be dissolved unless there is obtained the written consent of all the remaining members of the Company within 90 days after the occurrence of the terminating event.
