ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF BAW, LLC (Manager Managed)

- (g) To purchase, take, receive, lease or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use, and otherwise deal in or with, real or personal property, or any interest therein, wherever situated, and to sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, lease, exchange, transfer and otherwise dispose of real or personal property, or any interest therein;
