Pursuant to the provisions of the Code of Alabama, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Dissolution:

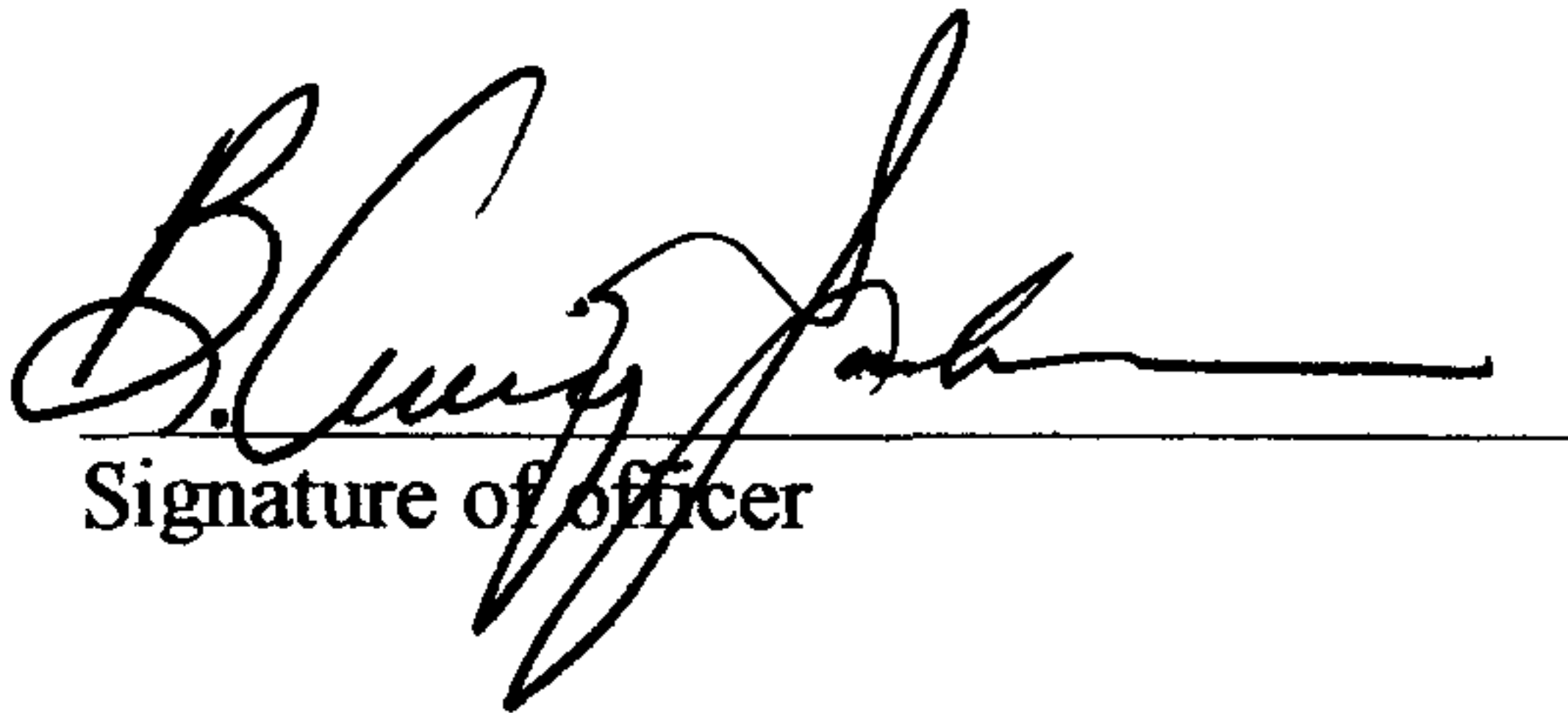
The name of the corporation is Home Medical Mart, Inc.

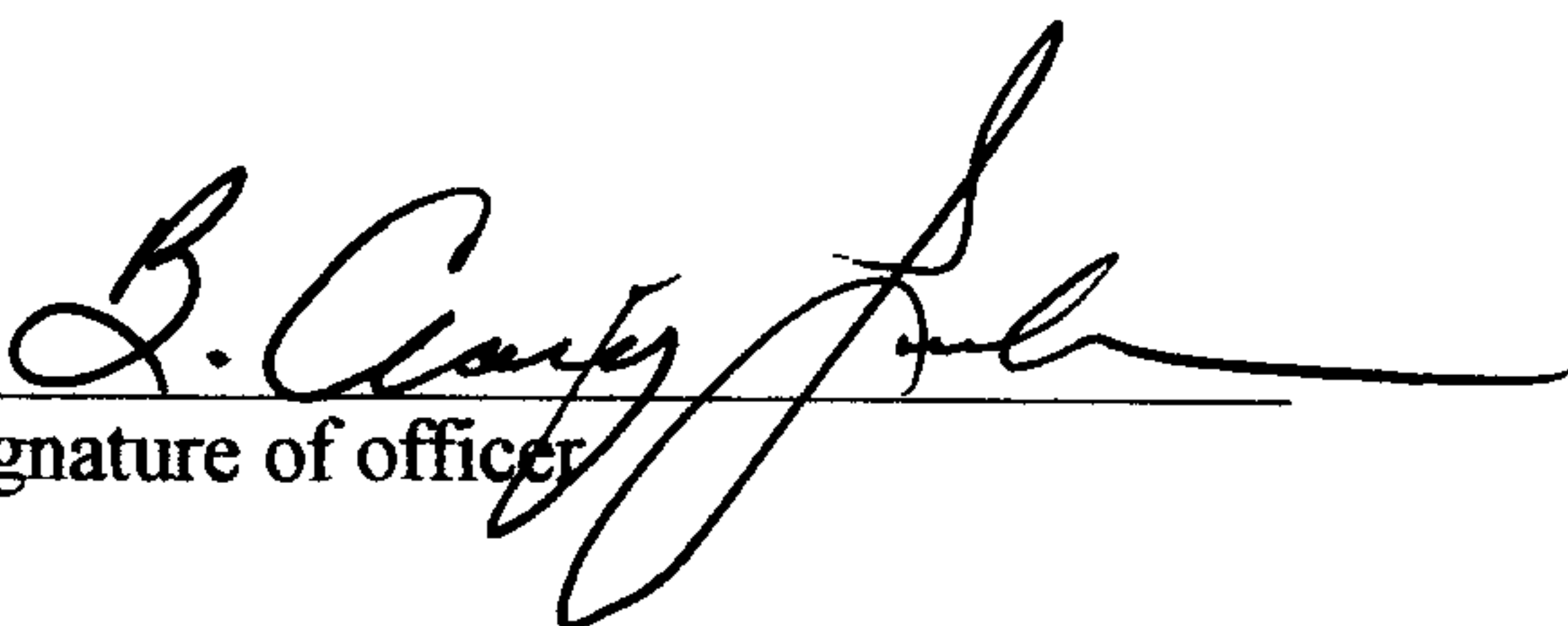

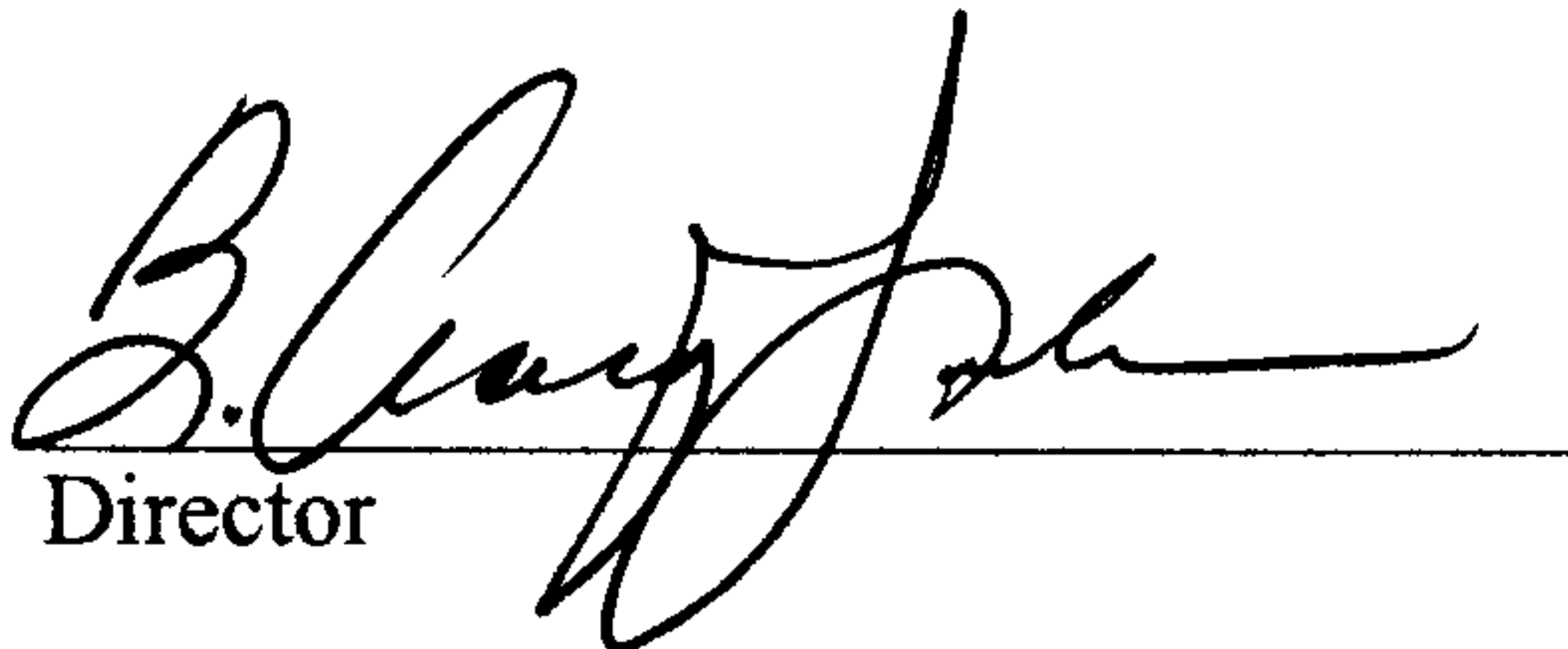

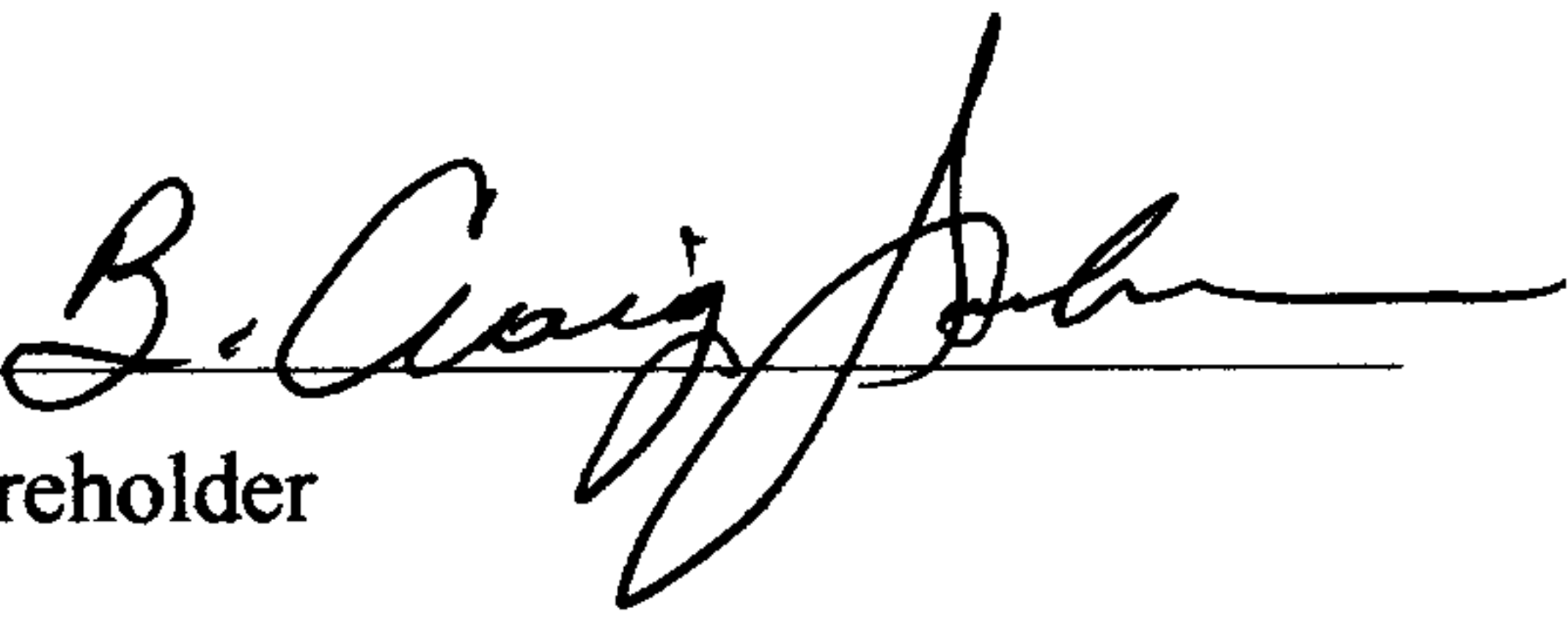
