

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF:

AMERICAN WOODWORKING and CABINETRY

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF PROBATE OF SHELBY COUNTY ALABAMA:

The undersigned - desiring to form a Limited Liability Company, under the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act of the Code of Alabama at Section 10-12-12 et seq. (1975) - hereby adopt the following Articles of Organization for said Limited Liability Company:

ARTICLE I

NAME: The name of the Company formed shall be "AMERICAN WOODWORKING and

CABINETRY."

ARTICLE II

DURATION: The Period of Duration of the Limited Liability Company (LLC) shall be One Hundred

(100) years - unless dissolved according to the provisions of the LLC Act. Upon the death, resignation, incompetency, expulsion, or bankruptcy of a Member, the remaining

Members shall have the right to unanimously agree - by written consent - within Ninety

(90) days, to continue the duration of the LLC.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE: The LLC has been organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business for

which a Limited Liability Company may be organized under the laws of the State of

Alabama - including:

CONSTRUCTION, FABRICATION and INSTALLATION of CABINETRY,

CASEWORK and MILLWORK.

ARTICLE IV

REGISTERED OFFICE and REGISTERED AGENT:

The Location and Street Address of the Initial Registered Office shall be: 3016 Spruce Drive, Helena, Alabama 35080.

The Registered Agent of the LLC shall be David Ross, whose address shall be that of the Registered Office.

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ARTICLE V

INITIAL MEMBERS AND INITIAL DIRECTORS:
