JOINT PLAN OF MERGER AND AGREEMENT OF MERGER BETWEEN EXCELL REHAB, LLC AND ARMITAGE REHABILITATION, INC. WITH EXCELL REHAB, LLC AS SURVIVING ENTITY

WHEREAS, Excell Rehab, LLC ("Excell") is an Alabama limited liability company organized in Montgomery County, Alabama, with its principal place of business at Montgomery, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, Tracy L. Wallace is the sole member, manager and officer of Excell Rehab, LLC; and

WHEREAS, Armitage Rehabilitation, Inc. ("Armitage") is an Alabama corporation incorporated in Shelby County, Alabama, with its principal place of business at Birmingham, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, the aggregate number of shares that Armitage is authorized to issue is1,000 common shares at a par value of \$1.00 each, of which 1,000 shares are outstanding and are owned legally and beneficially by Excell; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable for the benefit of both parties and Excell's member that the properties, businesses, assets, and liabilities of both parties be combined into one surviving entity, which shall be Excell Rehab, LLC;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual agreements herein contained, the parties hereto, in accordance with the applicable provisions of the laws of the State of Alabama agree as follows:

1. Merger. Armitage shall be and is merged with and into Excell, and Excell does hereby

merge Armitage with and into itself. On and after the effective date of this contemplated merger:

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- (a) Excell shall be the surviving entity, and shall continue to exist as a domestic limited liability company under the laws of the State of Alabama, with all of the rights and obligations of such surviving domestic limited liability company as are provided by § 10-12-1, et seq., Code of Alabama 1975.
- (b) Armitage, as a constituent corporation, pursuant to § 10-2B-11.06, <u>Code of Alabama</u> 1975, shall cease to exist and its property shall become the property of Excell as the surviving entity.
- 2. Articles of incorporation; By-Laws. The Articles of Organization and Operating Agreement of Excell shall continue as the Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws of the surviving entity.
- 3. Managers and Directors. The Managers and Directors of Excell shall be the Managers and Directors of the surviving corporation until their successors are duly elected and qualified under the Operating Agreement of the surviving entity.
- 4. Members of survivor. Each member of Excell outstanding on the effective date of the merger shall thereupon, without further action, become a member of the surviving entity.
- 5. Cancellation of Armitage shares. All authorized and outstanding common shares of Armitage, such shares being owned in their entirety by Excell, and all rights in respect thereof, shall be canceled forthwith on the effective date of the merger, and the certificates representing such shares shall be surrendered and canceled.
- 6. Approval. This Agreement and the Plan of Merger have been submitted to the members/ shareholders of Excell and of Armitage for approval as required by the laws of the State of Alabama. The proper officers of each corporation shall, and are hereby authorized and directed to, perform all such further acts and execute and deliver to the proper authorities for filing all documents, as the same may be necessary or proper to render effective the merger contemplated by this Plan and

Agreement.

7. Use of Armitage bank accounts and payroll accounts. Excell may use the bank accounts and payroll accounts now existing in the name of Armitage Rehabilitation, Inc., during the month of Feb., 2003, for administrative convenience.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, Excell Rehab, LLC and Armitage Rehabilitation, Inc., have caused this Agreement to be executed, under seal, in their corporate names by their respective officers and also by majorities of their board of directors on the 3rd day of February, 2003.
