ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF SHELBY ONCOLOGY PROPERTIES, LLC

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF PROBATE OF SHELBY COUNTY, ALABAMA:

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act, <u>Code of Alabama</u>, Section 10-12-1 <u>et seq</u>. (the "Act"), hereby certifies as follows:

1. NAME. The name of the limited liability company (the "Company") is:

- 2. <u>DURATION</u>. The period of duration of the Company shall be perpetual; provided, however, that the Company shall be dissolved and its affairs shall be wound up upon the occurrence of any event of dissolution specified in Section 10-12-37 of the Act.
- 3. <u>PURPOSES</u>. The Company has been organized for the purpose of owning, managing and leasing real estate. The Company may also transact any other lawful business for which a limited liability company may be formed under the Act, but nothing contained herein shall be construed as authorizing the Company to carry on the business of banking or insurance or to act as a trust company, securities broker, securities dealer or investment advisor.

- 7. <u>ADDITIONAL MEMBERS</u>. Additional members may be admitted to the Company only in accordance with the provisions of Section 10-12-31 of the Act.
- 8. <u>CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP OF ALL MEMBERS</u>. The cessation of membership of all of the members shall result in the dissolution of the Company unless, within ninety (90) days after the cessation of membership of the last member, the holders of all financial rights in the Company agree in writing to continue the legal existence and business of the Company and to appoint one or more new members.
- 9. MANAGEMENT OF THE COMPANY. The Company shall be managed by its member.
