## ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

### NORTH ALABAMA NOTARY SERVICES, L.L.C.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under Title 10, Chapter 12 of the Code of Alabama (1975), as amended (the "Alabama Limited Liability Company Act"), hereby file the following Articles of Organization with the probate judge of the county in which the initial registered office of the limited liability company will be located and affirm that the facts stated in these Articles of Organization are true and correct:

#### ARTICLE I

NAME OF COMPANY: The name of the limited liability company is NORTH ALABAMA NOTARY SERVICES, L.L.C. (the "Company").

#### ARTICLE II

DURATION: The period of duration of the Company shall be from the date of filing of these Articles of Organization with the Office of the Probate Judge for Shelby County, Alabama until the first to occur of the following:

- (1) Fifty (50) years from the date of filing of these Articles of Organization; or
- (2) Dissolution of the Company pursuant to the laws of the State of Alabama or the Operating Agreement of the Company, as in effect from time to time.

#### ARTICLE III

PURPOSES: The purposes for which the Company is organized are the provision of Notary Public services and to perform any and all lawful business that may be performed by a Limited Liability Company including, but not limited to, contract labor and to engage in any other business or activity that now or hereafter may be necessary, incidental, proper, advisable, or convenient to accomplish the foregoing purposes (including, without limitation, obtaining financing therefor) and that is not forbidden by the law of jurisdiction in which the Company engages in that business.

**ARTICLE IV**

**REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT FOR SERVICE OF PROCESS:** The location and mailing address of the initial registered office of the Company shall be 680 Forest Lakes Drive, Sterrett, Alabama 35147. The initial registered agent for service of process at the foregoing address shall be Kay Fleming.

**ARTICLE V**

**INITIAL MEMBERS:** The names and mailing addresses of the initial members of the Company are as follows:

**ARTICLE VI**

**ADDITIONAL MEMBERS:** Additional members may be admitted but only upon the unanimous written consent of the then existing members.

**ARTICLE VII**

**CONTINUITY OF BUSINESS:** Upon the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy, dissolution, or dissociation of a member, or the occurrence of any other event which terminates the continued membership of a member in the Company, the business of the Company shall not be continued and the Company shall be dissolved unless there is obtained the written consent of all the remaining members of the Company within 90 days after the occurrence of the terminating event.

**ARTICLE VIII**

**MANAGEMENT:** The Company shall be managed by a manager or managers. The names and mailing address of the managers who are to serve as managers until the first annual meeting of the members or until their successors are duly elected and qualified are as follows:


**ARTICLE IX**

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, constituting all the members of the Company, have executed these Articles of Organization this the 30 day of March, 2004.


