affirm that the facts stated in these Articles of Organization are true and correct:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the limited liability company ("Company") is ANCHOR COURIER

ARTICLE II

Duration

The Company shall continue in existence until it is dissolved in accordance with the

provisions of the operating agreement, or, if there is no operating agreement or no provision in

the operating agreement governing the duration of the Company, then in accordance with the
