

DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Maree E. Macon Blackwell, of Shelby County, Alabama, make, constitute, and appoint Earley C. Macon, Jr., of Jefferson County, Alabama, my true and lawful Attorney and authorize and empower him for me and in my name to perform the following in the event of my subsequent disability or incapacity:

1. To sell and convey in my name by deed in fee simple with general warranty in such manner, at such price and on such terms of payment as he may deem proper any land owned by me.
2. To enter into any arrangement or agreement for my health or welfare he considers to be necessary, proper, and desirable for my benefit with any Health Facility or physician in Jefferson County or elsewhere.
3. To manage my personal property, with authority to sell, assign, and transfer all or any part of my personal property of whatever nature and to use it as he deems proper and necessary including the authority to withdraw all or any part of any bank account, either checking or savings, that I now have or may hereafter acquire for my benefit.
4. To perform all other acts with respect to any property I own that he, in his judgment, considers necessary and desirable in the management of my affairs or person and to adjust any income tax problem I may have with the Internal Revenue Service.
5. This Power of Attorney may be revoked by the Grantor by furnishing notice in writing to the Attorney in Fact prior to any disability or incapacity.

AND I DO HEREBY ratify and confirm all things so done by my

said Attorney in Fact, as fully and to the same extent as if by me personally done and performed.
