This cause came on for trial and the court took testimony from the plaintiff and the defendant in open court. The requirements of residence, age and grounds for the divorce were satisfied.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, CONSIDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between Vivian Stricklin and Waymond L. Stricklin are hereby dissolved, and the said parties are forever divorced from one another by decree a vinculo matrimonii on the ground of incompatibility.

Neither party shall again marry except to each other until sixty (60) days after the date of this decree. If an appeal from this decree is taken within forty-two (42) days, neither party shall marry again except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that:

(1) PROPERTY AWARDS TO THE WIFE:

The following property is awarded to Vivian Stricklin: Giant Auto Parts, II, located in Calera, which includes the business and the acreage on which it sits, together with all improvements; the one-acre adjacent to Giant Auto Parts, II and the rental trailer situated on this one acre; the 80-acre farm outside of Clanton; the rental house and lot located on 20th Street in Calera, Alabama; and the marital residence located in Calera, and the six acres adjoining the marital residence. Waymond L. Stricklin is hereby divested of all right, title to and interest in all of these properties.

Vivian Stricklin is also awarded the Chris-Craft boat; the John Deere tractor; all vehicles in her name; the trailer located at Okomo Camp-Lay Lake; all household items, furniture, fixtures, and appliances in her possession; and all bank accounts in her name.

Vivian Stricklin is awarded all life insurance policies wherein the defendant is named as the insured. Mrs. Stricklin shall be named as the beneficiary of these policies. Mrs. Stricklin shall be responsible for the premiums on these policies. FILED IN OFFICE THIS THE 8 DAY.

(2) PROPERTY AWARDS TO THE HUSBAND:

The following property is awarded to Waymond L. Stricklin:
Waymond Stricklin Enterprises, formerly Giant Auto Parts, I; 16 acres
on I-65 at the Calera-Montevallo exit; and all of his other business
ventures, including Alabaster Auto Glass, Birmingham International Race-
way, and the Great Southern Racing and Promotion Company. Vivian
Stricklin is hereby divested of any right, title to and interest in any
of these properties.

Waymond L. Stricklin is awarded all vehicles in his name, and all
guns, fishing equipment, sporting goods, and tools which are presently
located at the marital residence.

Waymond L. Stricklin is awarded all household items, furniture
fixtures, and appliances in his possession.

(3) DEBTS:

Each party is responsible for paying all indebtedness owing
on all property, whether real or personal, awarded to him or her.

(4) UNSPECIFIED PERSONAL PROPERTY:

Each party is awarded any personal property which is presently
in his or her possession which has not been specifically awarded in
this decree.

(5) ALIMONY:

There is no alimony award.

(6) EXECUTION OF INSTRUMENTS:

Each party is hereby ORDERED to execute on behalf of the other
any document requested by the other in order to reflect the awards in
this decree.

(7) ATTORNEY'S FEES:

Each party shall pay his and her own attorney's fees.

Costs in this action are taxed as paid.
