
ORDINANCE NO.08-63-04



AN ORDINANCE TO ALTER, REARRANGE AND EXTEND THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF WILTON, ALABAMA SO AS TO EMBRACE AND INCLUDE WITHIN THE CORPORATE AREA OF SAID TOWN ALL TERRITORY WITHIN SUCH CORPORATE LIMITS AND ALSO CERTAIN OTHER TERRITORY CONTIGUOUS TO SAID TOWN.

WHEREAS, a certain petition signed by the property owners requesting territory therein described be annexed to the Town of Wilton, together with a map of said territory showing its relationship to the corporate limits of the Town, has been filed with the Town Clerk of the Town of Wilton; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined and found that the matters set forth and alleged in said petition are true, and that it is in the public interest that said property be annexed to the Town of Wilton; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Wilton as follows:

Section 1. That said Council hereby assents to the annexation of said territory to the Town of Wilton, Alabama, the corporate limits of the Town to be extended and rearranged pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 42, Article 2, Code of Alabama 1975 (Sections 11-42-20 through 11-42-43, as amended) so as to embrace and include said territory, in addition to the territory already within its present corporate limits, within the corporate area of said Town, which said territory is not within the corporate limits or "Town Boundary" of another municipality. Said territory is described as follows:



Section 2. The Town of Wilton hereby agrees to comply with those provisions of Act No. 604 enacted at the 1976 Regular Session of the Legislature of Alabama pertaining to the assumption and payment of an annexed fire district debt or the payment to said fire district of an amount equal to six times the amount of dues that the portion of said fire district being annexed paid to said fire district during the preceding year.

Section 3. That the Town Clerk shall file a certified copy of this Ordinance containing an accurate description of said annexed territory with the Probate Judge of Shelby County, Alabama, and also cause a copy of this Ordinance to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the Town of Wilton.
