## MORTGAGE

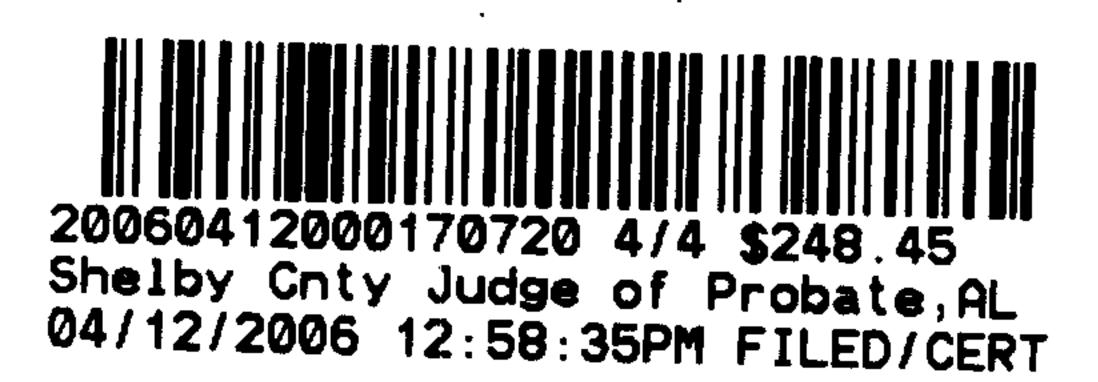
