ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION of BUG BUSTERS PEST CONTROL, L.L.C.

A Alabama Domestic Limited Liability Company

BE IT KNOWN that BUG BUSTERS PEST CONTROL, L.L.C., a limited liability company organized pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act, Code of Alabama, as amended. (1975) ("Act"), and the undersigned hereby adopt the following Limited Liability Company Articles of Organization and give notice to the Secretary of State of the State of Alabama, as follows:

ARTICLE I NAME

The limited liability company name is: BUG BUSTERS PEST CONTROL, L.L.C.

ARTICLE II DURATION


The period of duration is as of the filing of the Articles of Organization and shall continue until the earlier of:

- (1) December 31, 2055;
- (2) The written consent of the members and/or the managers to dissolve the Company pursuant to the Provisions of the Operating Agreement referred to below ("Operating Agreement");
- (3) The occurrence of an event of disassociation of a member specified under the Act, unless the legal existence and business of the company is continued pursuant to the Act or the Operating Agreement;
- (4) The entry of a decree of Judicial Dissolution under the act.

ARTICLE III PURPOSES

The Limited Liability Company has been organized for the following purposes:

To engage in the transaction of any or all lawful business for which Limited Liability Companies may be organized under the laws of the State of Alabama.



ARTICLE IV REGISTERED AGENT/OFFICE

Registered Office and Principal Place of Business. The street address of the office in Alabama required to be maintained under the Act and the principal place of business is in Shelby County Alabama at 103 Brookhollow Way, Pelham, AL 35124.

Registered Agent. The name and street address of the agent for service of process required to be maintained under Code of Alabama is to the following Attorney:

ARTICLE V SINGLE MEMBER

Names and Addresses of the Single Member is:



ARTICLE VI MANAGERS

The company is to be managed by one or more managers called a "Managing Member." The company shall have one manager. The name of the Managing Member is:

Billy D. Earnest, Jr.

The above-mentioned manager shall serve as such until his successor is elected and qualified pursuant to the operating agreement. The powers and authority of the manager are as described in the operating agreement and the act.



ARTICLE VII RIGHT TO CONTINUE BUSINESS

The company shall be dissolved and shall commence winding up its affairs upon the first to occur of the expiration of the term of the company or in accordance with the act.

After an event of dissociation of a member, the legal existence and business of the company is continued if: (i) there are at least two (2) remaining members or at least one (1) remaining member and a new member is admitted; (ii) the representative of the estate of the single member, who is herein automatically made a member upon the death of a single member, decides to continue the business and legal existence of the company, and (iii) within ninety (90) days after the event of dissociation, the holders of a majority of the company's remaining members agree in writing to continue the business and legal existence of the company.

A dissociated member is not entitled to be paid a buy-out price for her interest and shall have only the rights set forth in the company's operating agreement.

ARTICLE VIII REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION OF ADDITIONAL MEMBERS

Additional persons may be admitted to the company as a member and membership interests may be created and issued to those persons and to an existing member only upon such terms and conditions as are set forth in the operating agreement.

ARTICLE IV OPERATING AGREEMENT

The business of the company and the relationship of any member are subject to the terms and conditions of that certain operating agreement by and among the initial member. A copy of the operating agreement is maintained at the company's principal office.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, the undersigned member has executed these articles of organization effective as of the 1st day of June 2006 as his own voluntary act.
