Instructions: Step 1: The name of the Limited Liability Company must contain the words Limited Liability Company, LLC or L.L.C. Step 2: File the original and two copies of the Articles of Organization in the county where the LLC's registered office is located. The Secretary of State's flung fee is \$40. Please contact the Judge of Probate to verify the probate filing fee.  Pursuant to the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act, the undersigned hereby adopts the following Articles of Organization.

Article III	The Limited Liability Company has been organized for the following purpose(s):
