

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

Pursuant to the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act ("Act"), the undersigned acting as organizer of a limited liability company hereby adopts the following Limited Liability Company ("Company") Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE I

NAME

ARTICLE II

DURATION


The term shall expire on December 31, 2058, unless the Company shall be sooner dissolved and its affairs wound up in accordance with the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act or the Operating Agreement.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSES

The Company's business and purpose shall consist solely of the following:

- (a) To engage solely in the ownership, operation and management of the real estate project know as the Colonial Bank building located in Heflin, Alabama (the "Property"), pursuant to and in accordance with the Articles of Organization of the Company and the Operating Agreement of the Company; and
- (b) to engage in such other lawful activities permitted to limited liability companies by applicable laws and statutes for such entities of the State of Alabama as are incidental, necessary or appropriate to the foregoing.

ARTICLE VI


MANAGER
