DOMESTIC LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION GUIDELINES

INSTRUCTIONS:

STEP 1: THE NAME OF THE LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY MUST CONTAIN THE WORDS LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY, LLC OR L.L.C.

STEP 2: FILE THE ORIGINAL AND TWO COPIES OF THE ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION IN THE COUNTY WHERE THE LLC'S REGISTERED OFFICE IS LOCATED. THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S FILING FEE IS \$40. PLEASE CONTACT THE JUDGE OF PROBATE TO VERIFY THE PROBATE FILING FEE.

PURSUANT TO THE ALABAMA LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY ACT, THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY ADOPTS THE FOLLOWING ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION.

- Article I The name of the Limited Liability Company: Menawa Homes, LLC
(Your company title must end with the words Limited Liability Company, L.L.C. or LLC)
- Article II The duration of the Limited Liability Company is until termination under the terms of the Operating Agreement or the Articles of Organization
- Article III The Limited Liability Company has been organized for the following purpose(s):
Home construction and real estate development
- Article IV The street address (NO PO BOX) of the registered office: 109 Kilberry Way, Pelham, Alabama 35124 and the name of the registered agent at that office: Christopher D. Williams
- Article V The names and addresses of the initial member(s), and organizer (if any):

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF
MENAWA HOMES, LLC

We, the undersigned, desiring to form a Limited Liability Company pursuant to Section 10-12-1, et seq., of the Code of Alabama, hereby adopt the following Articles of Organization:

1. The name of the Limited Liability Company is **MENAWA HOMES, LLC**.

2. The existence of the Limited Liability Company shall commence on the date of the filing of the Articles of Organization in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, and shall continue in perpetuity, provided, however, that the Limited Liability Company shall be dissolved prior to such date (a) upon the written consent of the Members; (b) as provided in the Operating Agreement; or (c) as may be required by the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act.

3. The purposes for which this Limited Liability Company is organized are:

- (a) To invest in and develop real property and the construction or improvements thereto.
- (b) To engage in the transaction of any or all other lawful business for which Limited Liability Companies may be organized under the laws of the State of Alabama.

4. The location and mailing address of the initial registered office shall be:





6. The Members of the Limited Liability Company shall have the right to admit additional Members to the Limited Liability Company upon the unanimous written consent of all the Members of the Limited Liability Company

7. The Members of the Limited Liability Company shall have the right to continue the business of the Limited Liability Company upon the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy or dissolution of a Member or the occurrence of any other event which terminates the continued membership of a Member of the Limited Liability Company if the legal existence and business of the Limited Liability Company is continued by a written consent of all the remaining Members within ninety (90) days after the occurrence of the event of dissociation.
