

**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION  
OF  
LAWN BARBERS 205, L.L.C.**

Pursuant to the Provisions of Act No 93-724 of the 1993 Alabama Legislature, the undersigned hereby adopt the following Limited Liability Company Articles of Organization:

**ARTICLE I  
THE NAME OF THE LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY IS:**

The name of the limited liability company is **LAWN BARBERS 205, L.L.C.**, hereinafter referred to in these Articles of Organization as the "Company."

**ARTICLE II  
DURATION**

The period of its duration is perpetual; provided however, that the Company shall cease to exist upon the winding up of its affairs and its dissolution in accordance with Section 37 of the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act (the "Act").

**ARTICLE III  
PURPOSES**

The purpose for which the Company is organized is the transaction of any and all lawful business for which a limited liability company may be organized under the Act, including, without limitation, the following:

- a. To operate a landscape service to maintain landscapes, design landscapes, and install landscapes and all items related to landscape care, design, installation, and maintenance of residential and commercial properties.
- b. To borrow and lend money, without security, or upon the giving or receipt of such security as the Board of Directors, of the corporation may deem advisable by way of pledge, transfer assignment, or otherwise, of real and personal property of every nature and description, or by way of guaranty, or otherwise.
- c. To draw, make, accept, endorse, discount, execute and issue promissory notes, drafts, bills of exchange, warrants, debentures, and other negotiable or transferable instruments.
- d. To accomplish any lawful business whatsoever or which shall at any time appear to be conducive to or expedient for the protection or benefit of the Company or its property.

- e. To exercise all other powers necessary to or reasonably connected with the Company's business which may be legally exercised by limited liability companies under the Act or under the laws of any jurisdiction in which the Company may conduct its business.
- f. To engage in all activities necessary, customary, convenient, or incident to any of the foregoing.

**ARTICLE IV  
REGISTERED AGENT/OFFICE**

**ARTICLE V  
INITIAL MEMBERS**

**ARTICLE VI  
ADMISSION OF ADDITIONAL MEMBERS**

The members of the Company shall have the right to admit additional members to the Company in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Operating Agreement of the Company.

**ARTICLE VII  
CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP**

The circumstances under which cessation of membership of one or more members will result in the dissolution of the Company are as described in the Operating Agreement of the Company.

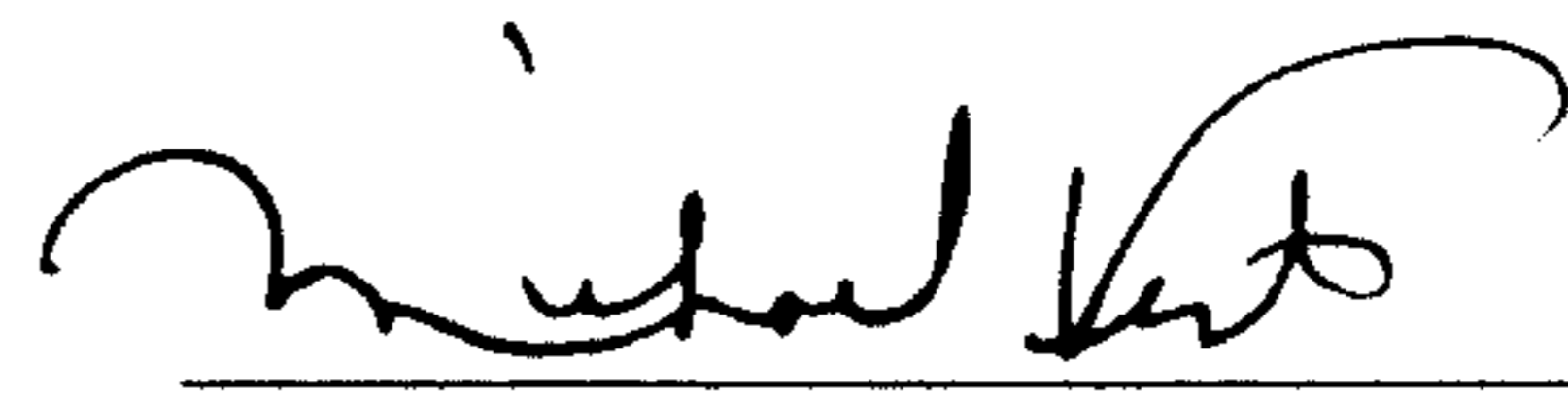
**ARTICLE VIII
