# ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF CHEERIODICALS, LLC

THE UNDERSIGNED, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company (the "Company") pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act and any amendments thereto (hereinafter the "LLC Act"), does hereby adopt the following Articles of Organization:

# Article 1 Name of Company

The name of the limited liability company is Cheeriodicals, LLC (hereafter "Company").

#### Article 2 Period of Duration

The existence of the Company shall commence on the date of the filing of these Articles of Organization in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, and shall continue perpetually; provided, however, that the Company shall be dissolved prior to that date upon the earlier to occur of: (i) the written consent of all the members to dissolve the Company; (ii) as provided in the Operating Agreement; or (iii) as may be required under the LLC Act.

#### Article 3 Purpose

The purpose for which the Company is formed is to own and operate a gift company, and any or all other lawful conduct for which a limited liability company may be organized.

### Article 4 Registered Office and Registered Agent

# Article 8 Dissolution of the Company

The cessation of membership of one or more members will result in the dissolution of the Company if there are no remaining members, unless the legal existence and business of the Company is continued and one or more new members is appointed in the manner provided in the Operating Agreement.

Any provision that is not inconsistent with the law for the regulation of the internal affairs of the Company is permitted to be set forth in the Operating Agreement of the Company.
