

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SCOTT ARMSTRONG MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND, AN ALABAMA NONPROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, whether one or more, for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under the Alabama Nonprofit Corporation Law, hereby adopts the following:

ARTICLE ONE

<u>NAME</u>

The name of this nonprofit corporation (hereinafter "the Fund") is Scott Armstrong Memorial Scholarship Fund.

ARTICLE TWO

<u>PURPOSES</u>

The purposes for which the Fund is organized are exclusively charitable and educational: to provide scholarships to graduates of Shelby County High School for secondary education. Solely for the above purposes, the Fund is empowered to engage in any lawful activities related to the stated purposes and in performing or engaging in those activities to exercise all rights and powers conferred upon nonprofit corporations under the Alabama Nonprofit Corporation Law, including, but without limitation, the right or power to receive gifts, devises, bequests, grants, donations, and contributions in any form, and to use, apply, invest and reinvest the principal and/or income therefrom or award or distribute the same to graduates of Shelby County High School.



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ARTICLE FOUR

NO MEMBERS



ARTICLE SEVEN

TAX EXEMPTION PROVISIONS

No part of the net earnings of the Fund shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Fund shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Two hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Fund shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Fund shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Fund shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or



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(b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE EIGHT

DISTRIBUTION UPON DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the Fund, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Fund is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.


