Once the Secretary of State's Office has indexed the filing, the information will appear at www.sos.alabama.gov under the Government Records tab and the Business Entity Records link – you may search by entity name or number. You may pay the Secretary of State fees by credit card if the county you are filing in will accept that method of payment (see attached). Your Amendment will not be indexed if the credit card does not authorize and will be removed from the index if the check is dishonored.

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

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AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF



ALABAMA CANINE RESCUE A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

Pursuant to the Alabama Business and Nonprofit Entity Code, the undersigned hereby adopts the following Amendments to its Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is Alabama Canine Rescue.

ARTICLE II

The date of filing of the articles of incorporation was October 5, 2011.

ARTICLE III

The following amendments were adopted in the manner provided for by the Alabama Business and Nonprofit Entity Code:

- A. Purpose. The organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Those purposes include:
 - 1. To rescue, house, feed, treat medically, and find homes for animals;
 - 2. To prevent cruelty to animals;
 - 3. To teach and promote the humane treatment of animals;
 - 4. To promote compliance with regulations and statuettes relating to the humane treatment of animals; and,
 - 5. To educate the general public regarding practices of proper animal care in Alabama.
- B. Dissolution: Upon the dissolution of this organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

ARTICLE IV

The amendment, consistent with the Alabama Business and Nonprofit Entity Code, was approved by a unanimous vote of the Directors.
