

CERTIFICATE OF FORMATION OF CHRIST FELLOWSHIP CHURCH

This Certificate of Formation of Christ Fellowship Church is being executed by the undersigned for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation pursuant to the provisions of Sections 10A-3-1.01, et seq., Code of Alabama (1975) as amended (the "Alabama Nonprofit Corporation Law").

ARTICLE I Name

The name of the nonprofit corporation (hereinafter referred to as either the "Church" or the "Corporation") shall be:



ARTICLE I1 Duration

The duration and existence of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE 111 Purpose

- (a) The Church is organized for the purpose of glorifying God by making disciples of all nations, and to do any and all other business, acts, and things incidental to such purpose as may be allowed under the laws of the State of Alabama.
- (b) The Church is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, literary, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), or the corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax law.
- (c) No part of the net earnings of the Church shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Church shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein. No substantial part of the activities of the Church shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Church shall not participate or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Certificate of Formation, the Church shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code or the corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax law, or (b) by an organization



contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code or the corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax law.

(d) The property of the Church is irrevocably dedicated to religious, charitable and educational purposes and no part of the net income or assets of the Church shall ever inure to the benefit of any director or officer thereof, or to the benefit of any private person.

ARTICLE IV Board of Directors

(a) The property, business, and affairs of the Church shall be managed by the Elders of the Church who shall serve as the Corporation's board of directors. The number of Elders constituting the initial board of directors of the Corporation shall be three (3). The names and addresses of the initial Elders are as follows:

(b) The number of Elders constituting the board of directors thereafter, the qualifications for Elders, the terms each shall serve, the means of their election, and the grounds and procedures for the removal of each shall be provided in the Bylaws of the Church.

ARTICLE V Members


The Church shall have members. The qualifications of membership shall be set forth in and prescribed by the Bylaws of the Church.

ARTICLE VI Initial Registered Office and Agent

The initial registered office of the Corporation shall be 247 Woodbury Drive, Sterrett, AL 35147, Jefferson County, Birmingham, Alabama 35147. The initial registered agent of the Corporation shall be Bart Box who shall be located at the initial registered office of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VII Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the Church, the board of directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Church, dispose of all of the assets of the Church exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such manner or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, literary,



or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as such under Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Code, or the corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax law, as the board of directors shall determine.

ARTICLE VIII Organizer


ARTICLE IX Amendment, Fundamental Corporate Change

This Certificate of Formation may not be amended, nor may the Church adopt a plan of merger, consolidation, or dissolution, without the affirmative votes of not less than two-thirds (2/3) of the votes entitled to be cast by members of the Church at an annual or special meeting of the members. Further, the Church may not sell, lease, exchange, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise dispose of all or substantially all of its property without the affirmative votes of not less than two-thirds (2/3) of the votes entitled to be cast by members of the Church in attendance at an annual or special meeting of the members.

ARTICLE X Liability

Pursuant to Sections 10A-20-16.01, et seq., Code of Alabama (1975), all noncompensated officers of the Church shall be immune from suit and not subject to civil liability arising from the conduct of the affairs of the Church except when the act or omission of such officer, which gives rise to a cause of action, amounts to willful or wanton misconduct or fraud, or gross negligence. For purposes of this Article X, the term "officer" shall include the Church's officers, directors (Elders), and the members of any other governing body of the Church.


