ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on April 18, 2011 on the Plaintiff's Motion to Alter, Amend or Vacate Order, or in the Alternative, For New Trial. 1. That Paragraph 4., of this Court's Order entered February 25, 2011 is deleted in its entirety.

- 4. All arrearage owed by the Plaintiff to the Defendant shall be paid within sixty days of the entry of this Order.
- 5. The Plaintiff remains in criminal and civil contempt of this Court's Orders and is sentenced to 150 days in the Jefferson County Jail. Said sentence is suspended pending further order of this Court.
- 6. All other provisions of this Court's previous Order in this cause, not otherwise modified herein shall remain in full force and effect.
- 7. This cause is set for hearing on July 20, 2011 at 9:00 a.m., to determine whether or not the Plaintiff is complying with the Court's Orders.
