ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

East River Place, L.L.C.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company unter Title 10, Chapter 17 of the Code of Alabama (1973), as amended (the "Alabama Limited Liability Company Act") hereby file the following Articles of Organization with the probate judge of the county in which the initial registered agent of the limited liability company will be located and affirm that the facts stated in these Articles of Organization are true and correct.

ARTICLE I

The name of the limited liability company is East River Place, L.L.C. (the "Company")

ARTICLE II

The period of duration of the Company shall be from the date of filing of these Articles of Organization with the Office of the Probate Judge for Shelby County, Alabama until the first to occur of the following:

- (a) Fifty (50) years from the date of filing of these Articles of Organization;
- (b) Dissolution of the Company pursuant to the laws of the State of Alabama or the Operating Agreement of the Company, as in effect from time; or
- (c) Upon the written unanimous consent of all the member of the Company.

(OR)

The period of duration of the Company is perpetual and shall continue until the first to occur of the following:

- (a) Dissolution of the Company pursuant to the laws of the State of Alabama or the Operating Agreement of the Company, as in effect from time to time; or
- (b) Upon the written unanimous consent of all the members of the Company.

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which the Company is organized are as follows:

- (a) To engage in the transaction of any and all lawful business for which limited liability companies may be organized under the laws of the State of Alabama;
- (b) To acquire, own, maintain, develop, improve, sell, lease or otherwise dispose of real estate;
- (c) To borrow money and to evidence the same by notes and other evidences of indebtedness and to secure the same by mortgage, deed of truct, pl.edge or other lien or security interest in furtherance of any of all of the purosees of the Company;
- (d) To enter into, perform and carry out contracts and agreements necessary, appropriate or incidental to the accomplishment of the purposes of the Company; and
- (e) To do any other acts and things which may be necessary, appropriate or incidental to the caring out of the business and purposes of the company, subject to the terms and conditions of this Operating Agreement.

ARTICLE IV

ARTICLE V

The name and mailing address of the initial member of the company is Dennis O'Brien, 3280 Hwy 31, Calera, Alabama 35040.

ARTICLE VI

The members of the Company shall have the right to admin additional members to the Company upon the unanimous consent of all of the member of the Company.

ARTICLE VII

The members of the Company shall have the right to continue the business of the Company upon the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy or dissolution of a member or the occurrence of any other event which terminated the continued membership of a member of the Limited Liability Company if (I there are at least two remaining members of at lease one remaining member and a new member is admitted; and (ii) the legal existence and business of the Company is continued by a written consent of all the remaining members within 90 days after the occurrence of the event of dissociation.

ARTICLE VIII

The Company shall be managed by its members.

ARTICLE IX

The members of the Company shall have no liability for any debt, obligation, or liability of the Company, as provided in the Alabama, limited liability Company Act.


