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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF TORQUE MARKETING GROUP, LLC

For the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Alabama Limited Liability Company Law and any act amendatory thereof, supplementary thereto or substituted therefor (hereinafter referred to as the "Law"), the undersigned does hereby sign and adopt these Articles of Organization, and, upon filing for record of these Articles of Organization in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, the existence of a limited liability company (hereinafter referred to as the "Company"), under the name set forth in Article I hereof, shall commence.

I. NAME

The name of the Company shall be Torque Marketing Group, LLC.

II. TYPE OF ENTITY

The Company shall be formed as a limited liability company.

III.

The term of the Limited Liability Company shall commence on the date of the filing of these Articles of Organization in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Madison County, Alabama, and shall be perpetual, provided, however, that the Limited Liability Company shall be dissolved (a) upon the written consent of all the Members; (b) as provided in the Operating Agreement; or (c) as may be required by the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act.

IV.

- A. Without limiting the scope and generality of the purposes, objects and powers of the Company granted by the Law, the Company shall have the power to:
- 1. engage in marketing and public relations with a social media focus in order to enhance business development and to engage in all other activities related or incidental thereto; and
- 2. engage in any lawful business, act or activity for which a company may be organized under the Law, it being the purpose and intent of this Article IV to invest the Company with the broadest purposes, objects and powers lawfully permitted a company formed under the Law.

B. All words, phrases and provisions appearing in this Article IV are used in their broadest sense, are not limited by reference to, or inference from, any other words, phrases or provisions and shall be so construed.

V. REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

- A. The location and mailing address of the initial registered office of the Company shall be 223 Pin Oak Drive, Chelsea, Alabama 35043.
 - B. The initial registered agent at such address shall be Caroline Lyle.

VII. ADMISSION OF ADDITIONAL MEMBERS

From and after the date of the formation of the Company, any person or entity acceptable to the Manager(s) of the Company as provided in the Operating Agreement by their vote thereof may become a Member in this Company either by the issuance by the Company of membership interests for such consideration as the Managers by their votes shall determine, or as a transferee of a Member's membership interest or any portion thereof as approved by the Managers by their vote, subject to the terms and conditions of these Articles of Organization and the Operating Agreement.

VIII. <u>CLASSES OR GROUPS OF MEMBERSHIP INTERESTS</u>

The relative rights, powers and duties for classes or groups of membership interests, if any, are set forth in full in the Operating Agreement of the Company, as the same may be in effect from time to time.

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IX. CONTINUATION OF BUSINESS

In the event of the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion or dissolution of a Member, the remaining Member or Members, if any, shall automatically continue the business of the Company.

X. MANAGEMENT

 - C. These Articles of Organization may be amended, altered, or repealed from time to time in the manner now or hereafter prescribed in these Articles of Organization, the Operating Agreement, or as permitted by the Law.

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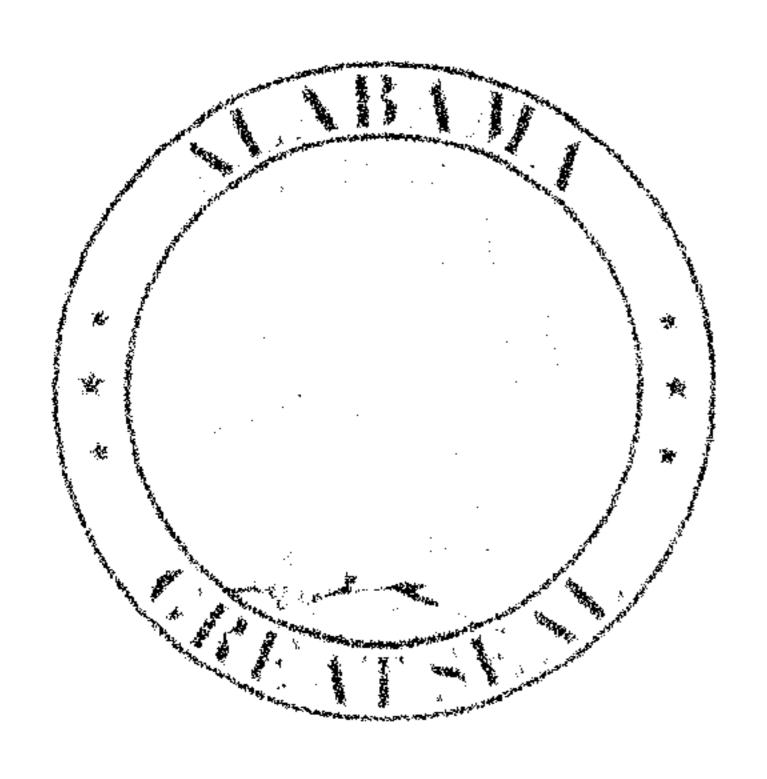
