

GENERAL DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

I, JOANNE S. WRIGHT, also known as, JOANNE WRIGHT, and JOANNE SMITH WRIGHT (and formerly known as JOANNE SMITH PIRKLE and JOANNE S. PIRKLE), of Madison County, Alabama ("Principal"), appoint LINDA A. BEACH to serve as my Attorney-in-Fact (herein called "Agent," whether one or more, including any "successor" Agent), and also appoint, SONYA N. HEIM to act as my alternate Agent, if for any reason my Primary Agent, LINDA A. BEACH, shall cease to serve as my Agent.


ARTICLE I

Durability. By this Instrument I intend to create a Durable Power of Attorney under Ala. Code S 26-1-2, as amended. This Power of Attorney shall not be affected by disability, incompetency, or incapacity of the principal, and my Agent shall continue to be able to exercise any power or authority I have given my Agent, regardless of my subsequent disability, incompetency or incapacity.

ARTICLE II


Authorities Granted. My Agent is authorized in my Agent's sole and absolute discretion:

- **A.** Real Property. This Power of Attorney specifically gives my Agent the power to manage, deal with, lease, mortgage, and/or sell any real property owned by me, or in which I have any interest, and any fixtures attached to my real property, any personal property used in connection with my real property, and any policies of casualty insurance on my real property.
- **B.** Sale of Assets. To sell or otherwise transfer any of my property, real, personal, or mixed, tangible or intangible, on such terms and conditions as my Agent may deem advisable, and to execute any instruments and give any warranties or indemnifications that my Agent may deem useful in effecting such sale or transfer.



- C. Insurance Policies. To apply for and own any policies of Insurance on any of my property, and against any liabilities or damages my Agent may deem advisable; pay any premiums or other charges required to maintain such policies; and exercise any incident of ownership over such policies, including, but not limited to, any right to cancel any policy, or make any elections with respect to the policies.
- D. Motor Vehicles. To apply for or transfer any certificate of title on any motor vehicle and to represent that such vehicle is free and clear of all liens and encumbrances not otherwise noted in the transfer documents.
- **E.** Tax Returns. To prepare, sign, and file any returns of tax, refund claims, request for extension of the time to file or pay; petition to any court with respect to any tax, offers, waivers, consents, powers of attorney (including Form 2848, and any other power of attorney form required) appointing my Agent or any suitable person selected by my Agent as my representative before the Internal Revenue Service, state, or local taxing authority, any other documents relating to any type of federal, state, local, or foreign tax; execute any elections I may have under any such tax laws; receive confidential information and copies of tax returns from the Internal Revenue Service, state or local taxing authorities, for which I waive any privileges I may have against disclosure of any confidential tax information to my Agent; negotiate checks payable for tax refunds or any tax benefits; and to engage and compensate attorneys, accountants or other professionals to represent me in any tax issues.
- F. Financial Accounts. To maintain any financial accounts, including, but not limited to, checking, savings, money market, brokerage firm, or credit union accounts presently in my name, establish new financial accounts in my name, and deposit money into, withdraw money from, and draw checks on these accounts.
- **G.** Investments. To invest and reinvest my funds in any type of investment, including corporate obligations of every kind, preferred or common stocks, bonds, Treasury securities, securities of any regulated investment trust, interests in partnerships, real estate, trusts, pooled trust funds, or annuity contracts without being limited by any statute or rule of law regarding investments by fiduciaries; to sell and terminate any investments, whether made by me or my Agent, and to invest in every other type of investment.

ARTICLE III



MISCELANEOUS

- A. Real Property. This Power of Attorney specifically gives my Agent the power to manage, deal with, lease, mortgage, and/or sell any real property owned by me, or in which I have any interest, and any fixtures attached to my real property, any personal property used in connection with my real property, and any policies of casualty insurance on my real property.
- B. Compensation and Expenses of my Agent. My agent shall be entitled to receive compensation for services rendered to me under this Power of Attorney, and to be repaid for all reasonable expenses incurred on my behalf under this instrument.
- C. Exculpation. My Agent while acting in good faith, is released from any liability to me or my estate arising out of the acts or failures to act of my Agent, except for willful misconduct or gross negligence. I agree to Indemnify and hold my agent harmless against any liability or expense, including attorney's fees that he or she may incur as the result of serving as my agent under this instrument, except for liability or expense resulting from willful misconduct or gross negligence.
- D. Revocation of Power. I hereby revoke all Powers of Attorney, general or limited, previously granted by me as Principal, and reserve the right to revoke this Power of Attorney by a written instrument. However, all persons shall recognize my Agent's authority to manage my affairs and transact my business under this instrument until receipt of a written notice of revocation. No one shall be liable to me or my estate for losses resulting from the good faith recognition of the authority of my Agent prior to receipt of a written notice or revocation.
- E. Counterparts. Anyone may rely fully, completely, and equally on the following: (1) the original of this Power of Attorney; (2) a duly executed counterpart; or (3) a copy certified by my Agent to be a true copy of the original Power of Attorney.
- hereafter commenced to appoint a guardian, conservator or other fiduciary to take charge of my person, or to manage and conserve my property, I hereby nominate and appoint my Agent above-named as my guardian, conservator, or other fiduciary, to serve without bond unless otherwise required by a court of competent jurisdiction.
- G. State Law. This Power of Attorney shall be governed by and construed according
