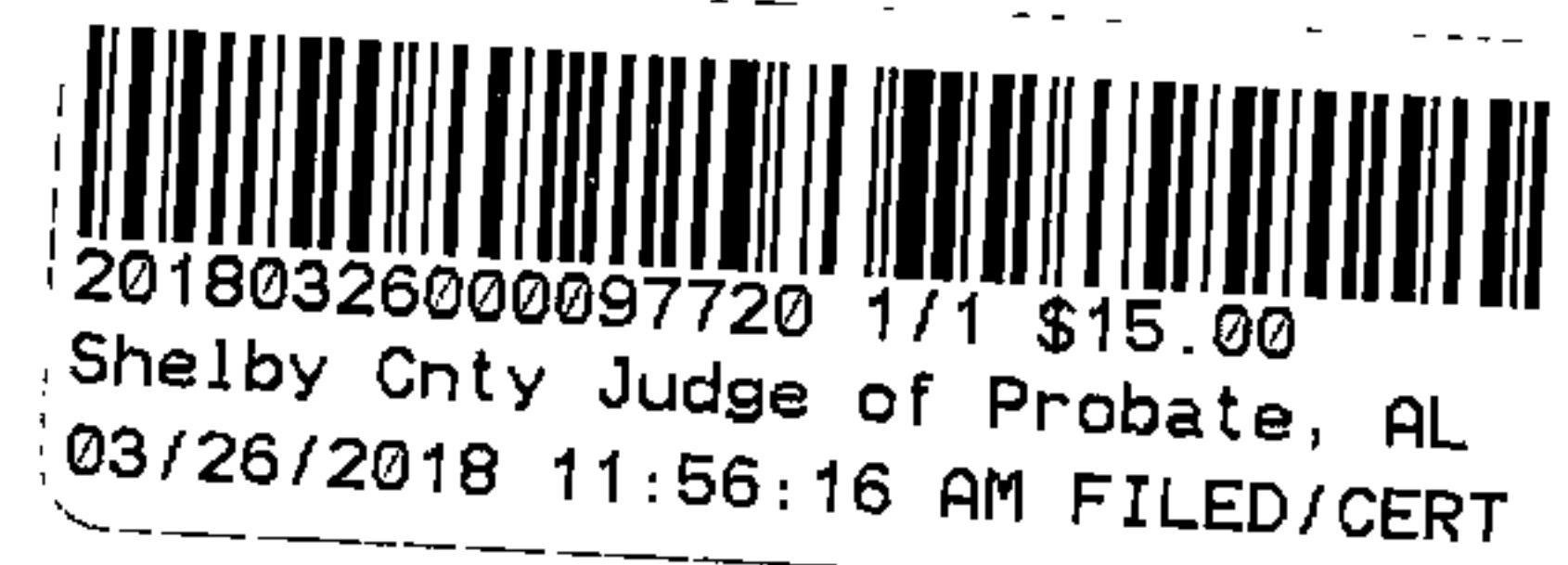


**HEIRSHIP AFFIDAVIT**


