ARTICLE ONE

NAME

The name of the corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation") is Helena's Buck Creek Festival.

ARTICLE TWO

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The purpose for which the Corporation is organized is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which nonprofit corporations may be organized under the *Alabama Business and Nonprofit Entity Code*, including, but not limited to:

• Engaging in all charitable, scientific, literary, educational or religious purposes in which an organization may engage as an organization qualifying as an Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) entity, and within the scope of such rulings and regulations interpreting such code section.

- Planning and coordinating a local community event which provides entertainment to families and individuals of all ages and donating the event's net proceeds to qualifying organizations such as schools, volunteer organizations and other nonprofit endeavors.
- The Corporation is to be deemed not-for-profit meaning that no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the Statement of Purpose hereof. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to the Corporation and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual.
- The Corporation will not engage in prohibited political and legislative activity and no substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE THREE

DURATION OF CORPORATION

The duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE FOUR


ARTICLE TEN
