**Order Motion For Default Judgment**

This matter comes before the Court on a Complaint filed by the Plaintiff to enjoin the Defendant from continued violations of the coverage provisions of the Alabama Workers' Compensation Law. The Defendant having failed to answer the complaint or file any document or make any argument in opposition thereto, and the Court having considered same, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

1. The Defendant shall secure and provide proof of workers' compensation insurance coverage to the Plaintiff within ten (10) days of the date of this Order. The Defendant is further enjoined from continued operation of the business until proof of coverage is provided to the Plaintiff.
2. The Court finds the Defendant guilty of a misdemeanor and imposes an immediate fine of \$1,000.00. Said fine shall be due and payable immediately to the Alabama Department of Labor – Worker's Compensation Division.
3. In addition to the fine above, the Court imposes a civil penalty against the Defendant in the amount of \$100.00 per day for each day the Defendant fails to provide proof of insurance coverage after the expiration of the ten (10) day

period as stated above.


4. The Defendant is responsible for the payment of all court cost.
