ty cents of lawful money of the State of
Alabama to me in hand paid by George
Gibson at or upon the sealing and delivering
of these presents hath given granted bargained
and sold and by these presents doth give
grant-bargain and sell unto the said George
Gibson his heirs Exec^r Adm^r & assigns all
the Household stuff implements & furniture
that is to say One Bedstead one bed and
furniture one trunk one Table one Cattor
wheel and all the Dishes furniture together
with all the cooking materials all & singular
which said premises are now remaining
standing and being in certain Message or
tenement situated in the County and State
aforesaid and now in the _____ of the said
J. Humphie - To have and to hold all and
singular the said goods Household stuff
and furniture and other the premises above
bargained and sold to the said Gibson his
heirs Exec^r Adm^r & assigns forever. And I
the said Humphie for myself my heirs
all and singular the said goods & chattels
unto the said Gibson his heirs &c I do mar-
tinent and defend by these presents of all and
singular which said goods I the said Hum-
phie have put the said Gibson in full
possession by delivering to him the said
Gibson a bed and furniture at the sealing
and delivery of these presents in the name
of the whole premises hereby bargained &
sold unto the said Gibson as aforesaid - In
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this 4th January 1821.
