I know all men by these presents that I James Kenphill of the County of Shelly and State of Alabama for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars & fifty cents, of lawful money of the State of Alabama to me in hand paid by George Gibson before or upon the realizing and delivering of these presents hatches given, granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain, and sell unto the said George Gibson his heirs, exec, Admr, & assigns all the house hold stuff implements and furniture that is to say - one bedstead - one bed and furniture - one trunk, one table, one cotton wheel and all the dinner furniture together with all the cooking material all and singular which said premises, now remaining

Manding & being in certain usage or tenement situate in the County & State aforesaid and now in the occupation of the said J. Humphill to have and to hold all and singular the said goods, chattels and furniture and other the premises above bargained and sold to the said Gibson, his heirs, executors & assigns forever And I the said Humphill for myself, my heirs, etc all and singular the said goods and chattels unto the said Gibson his heirs etc I do warrant and defend by these presents of all and singular which said goods I do said Humphill have put the said Gibson in full possession by delivering to him the said Gibson a bed & furniture at the sealing & delivering of these presents as the witness of the whole premises hereby bargained & sold unto the said Gibson as aforesaid. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 4th of January 1821.
