A.D. 1824. The condition of the above obligation  
is such, that whereas, the above bounden James  
N. Nabors, has been appointed assessor and  
collector of the taxes of Shelby County for the year  
eighteen hundred & twenty four. Now if the said  
James N. Nabors, shall faithfully execute & perform  
all the duties of said office and pay over such

monies as he may so collect according to law, then  
this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full  
force,
