 hold all and singular the premises before
 mentioned unto the said Robert S. Sheppard
 his heirs and assigns forever and I do
 hereby bind myself my heirs executors and
 administrators to warrant and forever
 defend all and singular the premises unto
 the said Robert S. Sheppard his heirs and

assigned against myself or my heirs, and against
any person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim
the same or any part thereof.
