bargained sold aliened and conveyed and  
do by these presents bargain sell and

convey unto the aforesaid Davis his heirs  
 Adm<sup>r</sup>, Executors or assigns or all that  
 tract or parcel of land lying & being  
 in Shelby County on the waters of Shoal  
 Creek containing one hundred and  
 fifty nine  $\frac{59}{100}$  acres and being in the  
 North East quarter of Section Number  
 Twelve Township Twenty Two Range Three  
 West in Tuscaloosa District together with  
 all and singular the Rights hereditament  
 and appurtenances in any way belonging  
 thereto which above described premises  
 I do hereby bind myself my Heirs  
 Ex<sup>r</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup> and assigns all unto the aforesaid  
 said Thos. J. Davis his Heirs Ex<sup>r</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup>  
 &c and wife forever defund and warrant  
 from myself my Heirs Ex<sup>r</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup> &c and  
 all and every other person or persons what-  
 soever In witness whereof I have here-
