

Wilson mm. This Indenture made this twenty fourth day of
 August one thousand eight hundred and twenty five between
 Cornelius Elliott of the County of Shelby, State of Alabama, of the one part, and Con-
 nelius Elliott of the County or state aforesaid of the other
 part, witnesseth, That the said William Wilson for a
 consideration of the sum of one hundred dol-
 lars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged hath this day bargained, sold
 aliened, enfeoffed a convey'd, and by these presents
 doth bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff and convey unto
 the said Cornelius Elliott all that certaine piece
 of land or tract of land, lying & being in the County
 and State aforesaid being all of the west half of the
 North West quarter of section, containing five of four-
 shup twenty one of Range eleven west, in the district
 of Tuscaloosa, and State of Alabama, which lies
 East of the following line to wit : beginning on the
 Southern boundary of said tract where it crosses
 Spring Creek, thence up said creek to the head
 thereof thence up a draft or wet weather branch
 to the northern boundary of said tract containing
 forty acres he the same more or less. To have and
 to hold the above described piece, parcel or tract of land
 with the tenements and appurtenances thereunto
 belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the
 said Cornelius Elliott his heirs & assigns forever
 And the said William Wilson for himself his
 heirs executors, administrators doth warrant and
 will forever defend the title to the above described
 and hereby granted premises unto the said Cornelius
 Elliott his heirs & assigns from and against
 the said William Wilson and all and every
 person or persons claiming or holding under the
 said William Wilson and also against the
 lawful, title, claim or demand of all and every
 person or persons whomsoever, claiming or holding
 by force or under the Government of the United
