 David Gage. eight hundred and twenty five thousand David
 Range 88. Gage of said County & State aforesaid, and Thomas
 H. Brainer & Elizabeth Brainer agent of Samuel
 Hawkins deed of the County of Shelly and State
 aforesaid. Witnesseth that the said Brainer hath bar-
 gained, sold & delivered unto David Gage a certain
 tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and
 twenty nine acres, be the same more or less being
 the Port East $\frac{1}{4}$ of fractioned section No. 2, Township
 no. 20. Range No. 3 East. for and in consideration
 of the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars to
 him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged the said Brainer agent of said Haw-
 kins did doth by these presents warrant and for-
 ever defend the rights of said land to David Gage
 his heirs & assigns forever from me or my heirs
 executors and administrators or assigns and all and
 every person or persons, whatsoever, whether in
 law or equity. In witness whereof we have
 hereunto set our hands & seals this 1st day of June

 J. W. Kidd the wife Elizabeth Brasher her
