

Bullard Allen This Indenture made this first day of December
 & Rebecca one thousand and eight hundred & twenty five between
 To Allen Bullard & Rebecca Bullard his wife of the
 James Gamble County of Shelby in the State of Alabama, of the me-
 past and James Gamble, of the other part,
 witnesseth that the said Allen Bullard and Rebecca
 his wife of and in consideration of the sum of
 three hundred dollars to them in hand paid
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath
 this day bargained, sold aliened enfeoffed and con-
 veyed, and by these presents doth bargain, sell
 alien, enfeoff and convey unto the said James
 Gamble all that certain greater number lying
 being in the County & State of aforesaid being the
 west half of the South East quarter of section
 thirty six in township twenty in Range the
 west containing seventy nine acres and seventy-
 five hundredths of an acre according to the of-
 ficial plat of the survey of the said land retained
 to the general land office by the surveyor General
 being of the lands sold at Tuscaloosa State of Ala-
 bama, to have and to hold the above described
 half greater number of land with the tenements
 and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any
 wise appertaining unto the said James Gamble
 their heirs & assigns forever and the said Allen
 Bullard & Rebecca Bullard his wife for them-
 selves their heirs, executors and administrators
 doth warrant and will forever defend the title
 to the above described and hereby granted unto the
 said James Gamble his heirs & assigns to the
 said James Gamble his heirs & assigns the
 said Allen & Rebecca Bullard and all other
 persons or persons claiming or holding under
 them the said Allen & Rebecca Bullard his

his wife all also against the lawful title claim
 or demand of any and every person or persons claiming
 as to claim or holding by, from or under the Govern-
 ment of the United States. On testimony whereof the

 arately examined apart from her husband ac-
 knowledged that she signed, sealed & delivered the
 within deed freely without any fear threats or
 compulsion of her said husband.
