

Amby Willis This Indenture made this fifth day of September
 1^o thousand one thousand eight hundred and
 twenty five between Willis Amby of the County
 of Shelly in the State of Alabama, of the one
 part and James Edge of the County & State
 aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the
 said Willis Amby for and in Consideration
 of the sum of four hundred dollars to him
 paid the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
 knowledged both this day last and will
 confirm and convey and lay this Deed
 with bargains, all cles, enfranchises and convey
 unto the said James Edge all that certain
 piece, parcel or tract of land lying and being
 in the County & State aforesaid being the west
 half of the South West quarter of section eleven
 of township twenty one of range three west
 in the district of Tuscaloosa in the State of
 Alabama, containing nearly nine acres and
 nearly five hundredths of an acre according
 to the official plat of the survey of said lands
 returned the General Land Office by the Surveyor
 General to have and to hold the above described
 piece, parcel or tract of land with the tenements
 and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any
 wise appertaining unto the said James Edge
 his heirs & assigns forever and the said Willis
 Amby for himself, his heirs, executors and
 administrators doth warrant & will further
 defend the title to the above described and
 hereby granted premises unto the said
 James Edge his heirs & assigns from and
 against himself and all and every person
 or persons claiming or holding under him
 the said Willis Amby, and also against the

lawful title claims or demand of all and every
person or persons whom soever claiming or holding
by force or under the government of the United
States. In testimony the said Willis Aarly hath
presented at his hand and seal the day & year above
written.
