to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged hath this day bargained

sold aliened, enfeoffed & conveyed & by these presents the
 bay and all alien, enfeoff, convey unto the said Little
 Page Sims all that certain half quarter section of land
 lying & being in the State & County aforesaid being the
East half of the South East quarter of Section twenty-five
 in Township twenty of Range three west in the
 district of Tuscaloosa, and State of Alabama containing
 seventy nine acres, and seventy nine hundredths of an
 acre, according to the official plat of the survey of said
 lands returned to the general Land office by the Sur-
 veyor General to have and to hold the above described half
 quarter section of land with the tenements & appur-
 tenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining
 unto the said Little Page Sims and his heirs and
 assigns from & against the said Christopher Butler
 and every Person or persons claiming or holding
 under him the said Christopher Butler and also
 against the lawful title claim & demand of all
 and every person or persons whatsoever claiming
 or holding by him or under the Government of the
 United States. In testimony whereof the said Christo-
 pher Butler have hereunto set his hand & seal the
 day & year above written.
