 part, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of
 the sum of six hundred dollars in hand paid
 by John Aldham, of the State & County aforesaid
 of the other part, Witnesseth that for and in con-
 sideration to the said Benjamin May the said
 Benjamin May hath bargained and sold and
 by these presents, doth bargain, and sell unto the
 said John Aldham, ten certain tracts of land
 lying & being in the County and State aforesaid
 to wit: the West half of the west west quarter
 of section twenty three, in township nineteen
 of Range ten west, in the district of Tuscaloosa
 and State of Alabama, containing eighty
 acres, and twenty seven and a half hundred
 & an acre, and also the east half of the South

last quarter of section twenty nine of township
 nineteen of range two west in the district
 of Marealosa and State of Alabama, containing
 twenty nine acres, and twenty five hundredths
 of an acre, to have and to hold the tract of
 land above described with the covenants &
 here ditained and all and singular the
 premises above mentioned and every part
 and parcel thereof, to the my proper use
 and benefit and behof of the said John
 Aldham, his heirs & assigns forever, and the
 said Benjamin May, for himself & his heirs
 he said land the above mentioned and the
 said John Aldham his heirs & assigns free
 from the claim or claims of him the
 said Benjamin May or his heirs & all and
 every person or persons whatsoever, shall well
 and we warrant and forever defend his
 these presents, in witness whereof the said
 Benjamin May have hereunto set his hand
 and affixed his seal the day & year above
 written.
