 well and truly to be made we bind ourselves

our his exutors and administrators jointly or
 severally, jointly and by their presents, signed
 with our names and sealed with our seals
 this 15th day of August, in the presence of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven
 Whereas the said above bound Abadial Harris
 has been elected clerk of the County Court of the
 County of Shelby at the general election in
 August 1827, now the condition of the above
 obligation is such that if the said above bound
 Abadial Harris shall and do faithfully execute
 the duties of the said office of clerk to which he
 is elected, and do not remove or carry or
 suffer to be removed and carried out of the
 County of Shelby the records & papers of the
 Court whereof he is clerk or any part thereof
 except in cases allowed by law, but shall in
 all things pertaining to said office faithfully
 discharge the duties thereof, then this obliga-
 tion to be void, otherwise to remain in full force
 & effect.
