 hundred due the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January next  
 for one hundred & twenty dollars with lawful  
 interest from its date, and the said John An-  
 drews being willing to receive the payments  
 of the above mentioned note to the said King  
 now this indenture witnesseth that in con-  
 sideration of the premises and also for the  
 sum of one dollar to the said John Andrews  
 paid by the said James N. Burke the Trustee  
 at or before the sealing of these presents, the  
 Recd, whereof is hereby acknowledged the  
 said John Andrews hath given, granted bargained  
 & sold, alined, saufed, released & confirmed  
 to the said James N. Burke, the (Trustee) his  
 heirs & assigns forever, a certain negro boy  
 slave named Gus, about twelve years old  
 and the said John Andrews for himself, his  
 heirs & doth hereby covenant, promise & agree  
 to & with the said James N. Burke his heirs  
 assigns forever, in manner following viz:  
 The said John Andrews to the said James  
 N. Burke his heirs & assigns against all  
 manner of persons whatsoever, shall & will  
 warrant and forever defend by these presents  
 upon trust nevertheless that the said  
 James N. Burke, his heirs & assigns shall  
 permit the said negro boy above mentioned  
 to remain in the quiet & peaceable possession  
 of the said John Andrews, and to take the  
 profit to his own use & benefit: until de-  
 fault be made in the payment of the said  
 note of one hundred & twenty dollars or so  
 before the fifteenth day of January next and  
 upon default of the payment of the said  
 sum of one hundred & twenty dollars aforesaid  
 or so soon thereafter as the said King shall  
 direct the said James N. Burke (Trustee)  
 is hereby authorized & empowered to advertise  
 said negro boy at three or more public places  
 thirty days for sale, at the expirations of  
 which time the said trustee is to sell  
 said negro boy for cash to the highest

bidders, and is hereby empowered to make full & compleat titles to the same, and out of the money arising from this said sale or said negro boy pay to the said Edmund Krieg the said sum of one hundred & twenty dollars together with the law-  
fees incurred that may accrue, on said note,  
from the time it is given and do remainders  
if any shall be paid to John Andrew. But if  
the said John Andrew does well and truly  
pay off this said note, before the day of sale  
then this indenture to be void, otherwise to  
remain in full force & effect.
