This instrument made this the eleventh day of February, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty eight between Arthur Tabos, and Sally Tabos his wife of the one part, and David Meredith of the other part both parties of the County and State aforesaid witnesseth that the said Arthur Tabos and Sally his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted, bargained, sold and conveyed unto the said David Meredith a certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated lying & lying in the County aforesaid being part of the last half of the South West quarter of section four in Township Twenty one in range three west of the lands sold at Tuscaloosa beginning at the North East corner of the aforesaid tract of land thence west eighty rods, to the North West corner of said tract thence South fifty two rods, with the west line of said tract, thence east twenty four rods, thence a south easterly course to the east line of said tract and thence north with said line to the beginning, to as to contain twenty eight acres, and fifty hundredths of an acre to have and to hold the said tract of land with all and singular the heretofore described

where appertaining or in any way belonging
 to the said David Murdoch his heirs, assigns
 executors, or administrators from the said Arthur
 Nabors and Sally his wife their heirs, assigns
 executors, or administrators the title to which said
 tract of land the said Arthur Nabors and Sally
 his wife will warrant and forever defend against
 every person and persons whatsoever claiming
 or holding under the government of the United
