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This Indenture made this 23 day of October one thousand eight hundred and twenty-eight between Wiley Shaw of the County of Shelby in the State of Alabama of the one part, and Benjamin Sennin of the other part witness that the said Wiley Shaw for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty Dollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath this day bargained sold all and enfeoffed and conveyed and by these presents doth bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff and convey unto the said Benj. Sennin all that tract and parcel of land lying and being in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama, and being the tract or lot or the North East quarter section four, in township twenty one of Range three west in the District of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama containing eighty acres, and twenty nine hundredths of an acre, according to the plan plat laid by the said Wiley Shaw, from the United States to have and to hold the above described land with the improvements and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Benjamin Sennin and his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Wiley Shaw for himself and his heirs, executors and administrators do warrant and will forever defend the title to the above described and hereby granted premises unto the said Benjamin Sennin and his heirs & assigns forever, and the said Wiley Shaw for himself and heirs, executors, administrators do warrant and will forever defend the title to the above described and hereby granted premises unto the said Benj. Sennin and his heirs and assigns from and against the aforesaid Wiley Shaw himself and his heirs, and also against the lawful title claim or demand of all and every person or persons whomsoever law-

ing the same, or holding by from or under  
the Government of the United States.
