Smith fifty seven dollar damage sustained
by their non performance of a certain agree-
ment and promises, besides his costs about
his suit vis that behalf expended, and wheras
by an order of sale issued out of said Circuit
Court, dated the day as above specified di-
rected to me as Sheriff aforesaid command-
ing me to execute to sell the West half of the
North west quarter, of section seven, and
township twenty and range two east, to
satisfy Thos. Wm. Smith his dollar dam-
ages, sustained by reason of the non per-

from me of certain provisions and understanding
 besides cost, of suit in that behalf expended
 And whereas after the coming of said suit
 to me and upon the said Sheriff did by
 virtue of the said writ seize and take in the
 lands herein after particularly described in my
 County of the said Jacob Vanderbulte rightly
 the said execution or order of sale sold the said
 lands as herein after mentioned at public auc-
 tions, according to the statute in such cases
 made and provided, to Jas. N. Smith for one
 hundred and nine dollars the highest sum
 bid for the same, now know ye that I the said
 Sheriff as aforesaid by virtue of the said writ
 of execution and order of sale and of the
 statute in such cases made and provided
 in considerations of the said sum of one
 hundred & nine dollars, to be in hand paid
 by the said Jas. N. Smith the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained
 sold & by these presents do grant, bargain, sell
 unto the said Jas. N. Smith and to his
 heirs & assigns forever all the tract or parcel
 of land lying and being in the County of
 Shelly, however and designated as follows
 the west half of the south & quarter of sec-
 tion seven, township twenty and wages
 due aent, with its appurtenances and all
 the estate, right, title and interest which the
 said Jacob Vanderbulte had in the said
 tract prior or paral of said land on the
 eleventh day of April 1828 the time in which
 the attachment was levied on said land
 on which the judgment was rendered
 on which said execution was issued
 or at any time since had and may just
 thereof with the appurtenances unto the said
 Jas. N. Smith his heirs & assigns forever
 as fully and absolutely as I the said Jas.
 N. Talors Sheriff as aforesaid and under
 the authority aforesaid might could or
 ought to convey the same.
