 sum of consideration of the sum of one hundred and
 ten dollars, to the said James W. Smith in
 hand paid by the said Josiah Henderson the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged last
 this day granted, bargained, aliened, sold and
 conveyed, and by due process, doth grant
 bargain, also, sell & convey all that certain
 tract of land lying & being in the County of
 Shelby as follows: to wit: The East half of the
 North west quarter, of section seven, township
 twenty of range two east, of the lands sold at
 public auction to have and to hold the said tract
 of land, with every part and parcel thereof
 with all and singulars the hereditaments there
 unto belonging or appertaining to the said land
 and premises, from the latter to which tract of
 land the said James W. Smith doth warrant
 and will forever defend, against all persons
 or persons, claiming or holding under the
 Government, of the United States.
