

Lolly Juniah The state of Alabama, This indenture made & done
 Shelly County, This fifteenth day of 7 Febra-
 ry, 1824, between Jeremiah Lolly of this County a
 State aforesaid of the one part, and David Fletcher
 of the said State & County, aforesaid of the other
 part, Witnesseth that the said Jeremiah Lolly for &
 his considerations of the sum of three hundred
 dollars, by the said David Fletcher to the said
 Jeremiah Lolly, to him in hand paid and
 acknowledged receipt given, granted, bargained
 and sold and by these presents doth give grant
 bargains & sell unto David Fletcher all that par-
 cel of land lying & being in Shelly County
 State of Alabama, known by Twp of North N.
 gr sec. 4 Range 3 west, of the Meridians line
 granted to Jeremiah Lolly, 10th May 1824, contain-
 ing 8.0 $\frac{7}{100}$ acres. to have and to hold the said land
 with all and singular the rights, privileges and
 appurtenances therunto belonging, and I the
 said Jeremiah Lolly do covenant and agree
 to & with the said David Fletcher that he
 the said Fletcher shall leave quiet and peace-
 able possession of the above shid land and
 I the said Jeremiah Lolly do warrant and
 defend the aforesaid tract of land from the
 claims of all persons whatsoever unto the
 said D. Fletcher his heirs & assigns forever.
 In conformity whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand & seal the year & day above written
