To all to whom these presents shall come I James M. Nabors Sheriff of the County of Shelby Alabama, send greeting whereas by a writ of alias execution issued out of the County Court for the County of Shelby to me directed and delivered the first execution titled the seventeenth day of September eighteen hundred and twenty seven and the second titled in the twenty second day of February eighteen hundred and twenty eight I was commanded as heretofore to make of the goods & chattels lands and tenements of Elizabeth Wilson & Samuel Nalns in my county, the sum of six hundred & eighty four dollars, and forty four cents which Samuel N. Wardis had record against them in the said Court, for his debt, and damages which he had sustained as well by reason of the loss as for his costs, and charges and that if sufficient goods and chattels could not be found that then I should cause the said debt and damages to be made of the lands and tenements, whereof the said Elizabeth and said Samuel was seized on the first day of September eighteen hundred and twenty seven, or at any time afterwards in whose hands the same might be found as by the said writ of execution required being debts had more fully appears, and whereas after the coming of said writ to me and before the day of the return, of said alias writ I did by virtue of the said writ seize and take the parcel of land herein after mentioned and leave for want of goods and chattels in my county of the said Elizabeth Wilson to satisfy the said debt and damages sold the said tract or parcel of

land as herein after mentioned at public auction according to the Statutes in such cases made & provided to Samuel N. Mardis for three hundred and fifty one dollars being the highest sum bid for the same. Now know ye that I James W. Nalors, the Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said alias execution and of the Statute in such cases made and provided, in consideration of the said sum of three hundred & fifty ^{one} dollars to me is land paid by the said Samuel N. Mardis, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained, & sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell unto the said Samuel N. Mardis his heirs & assigns forever the West half of the North West quarter of section eleven, of township twenty two, and range three west, with its appurtenances, and all the estate right, title and interest which the said Elizabeth had in the said premises, parcel or tract of land on the said seventh day of September eighteen hundred and thirty seven, or at any time since had or now has to hold and to have the said land and premises and any part thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Samuel N. Mardis his heirs assigns forever, as fully and absolutely as I the said James W. Nalors, as Sheriff aforesaid and under the authority aforesaid, might, could or ought to sell and convey the same.
