To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting,
 I J. D. Shelley, Sheriff of the County of Shelby State
 of Alabama, send greeting. Whereas a writ of alias
 execution issued out of the Circuit Court of Shelby
 County to me directed & delivered the first execution
 dated November the 30th Eighteen hundred and
 twenty seven and the second dated the 20th Sep-
 tember eighteen hundred and twenty eight
 I was commanded as heretofore to make of the goods
 & chattels of William Monday in my county
 the sum of ninety four Dollars, thirty eight
 & 1/2 cents which the said Monday had recovered
 against him in the said County Court for debt
 and damages which he had sustained as well
 by reason of the non payment of the debt as
 for his costs & charges and that sufficient goods
 & chattels could not be found that then I should
 cause the said debt & damages to be made of the
 lands and tenements whereof the said Wm.
 Monday was seized on the 30th November
 eighteen hundred and twenty seven or at
 any time afterwards in whose land & posses-
 sion the same might be found as by the
 said writ of execution reference being thereunto
 had more fully appeared, and whereas after
 the coming of the writ to me and before the
 day of the return of the alias writ I did by
 virtue of the said writ seize and take the tract
 or parcel of land herein after mentioned and
 have for want of goods & chattels in my county
 of the said William Monday to satisfy the
 said debt & damages, sold the said tract or par-
 cel of land as is herein after at public auction
 according to the Statute provided to James M.
 Nabors for five dollars being the highest sum
 bid for the same. Now know ye that I the
 said J. D. Shelley the Sheriff aforesaid by virtue
 of the said alias writ of execution and of the
 Statute in such cases made and provided in
 consideration of the said sum of five dollars
 to me in hand paid by the said James M. Na-
 bors the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have granted, bargained & sold and by these
 presents do grant, bargain & sell unto the
 said James M. Nabors his heirs & assigns for-
 ever, the West half of North East quarter of

Section ten in township seventh Range one East with its appurtenances and all the estate right, title and interest which the said William Monday had in the said tract, piece or parcel of land on the third of November eighteen hundred and twenty eight or at any time since had or now hath to have and to hold the said land and premises and any part thereof with the appurtenances unto the said James M. Nabors his heirs & assigns forever, as fully and absolutely as I the said J. D. Shelly as Sheriff aforesaid and under the authority aforesaid might, could or ought to sell and convey the same.
