

Shelly Jacob D. I, all to whom these presents shall come S. J. D.  
 Sheriff : Shelly Sheriff of the County of Shelly Alabama  
 and Greeting, Whereas by a writ or alias exec-  
 cutio[n] issued out of the Circuit Court of Shelly  
 County and to me directed and delivered the first  
 named the thirtieth November eighteen hun-  
 dred and twenty seven the record dated the  
 third October Eighteen hundred and twenty  
 eight I was commanded as herebefore to make  
 of the goods & chattels land and tenements of  
 Thomas J. Davis Smith L. Young and Mrs.  
 A. Wilson in my county the sum of four  
 hundred & thirty three dollars and ninety six  
 cents which Mary M. Porter Administering of  
 M. S. Porter demand had recovered against them  
 in the said Circuit Court for his debt and  
 damages which he had sustained as well by  
 reason of the debt as for the costs and char-  
 gage, and that if sufficient goods & chattels  
 could not be found that there should then  
 cause the said debt and damages to be  
 made of the lands and tenements which  
 the said Thomas J. Davis Smith L. Young

and William G. Wilson was seized on the 16<sup>th</sup> day  
of October eighteen hundred and twenty eight  
or at any time afterwards in whose hands were  
the same might be as by the said writ of execu-  
tions wherein being thereunto had been  
fully appears and whereas after the coming  
of the said writ to me and before the return of  
the said alias writ I did by virtue of the said  
writ leave and take the said land pointed  
out by said Thomas J. Davis his heir after men-  
tioned and have by receipt of said Thomas  
J. Davis sold the said tract or parcel of land  
as herein after mentioned at public Auction  
according to the Statute in such cases made  
and provided to of us vs M. Nabors and Daniel  
C. Waterson for the sum of Three hundred  
and five dollars being the highest sum bid  
for the same. Now know ye that I the said  
J. D. Shelly Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the  
said alias writ of execution and of the Statute  
in such cases made and provided in  
consideration of the said three hundred and five  
Dollars to me in hand paid by the said Jas.  
M. Nabors and Daniel C. Waterson the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged to have granted  
bargained and sold and by these presents do  
grant bargain, sell unto the said James  
M. Nabors and Daniel C. Waterson his heirs  
and assigns forever the North West quarter  
of section ninety, township twenty two range  
two west, also the East half of the North East  
quarter of section eight township two  
range two west, with its appurtenances and  
all the estate right title and interest which  
the said Thomas J. Davis had in the said  
tract, place or parcel of land on the said  
third day of October eighteen hundred and  
twenty eight or at any time since had or  
now hath to hold and to have the said  
land and premises and every part thereof  
with appurtenances unto the said James  
M. Nabors & Daniel C. Waterson his heirs &  
assigns forever as fully and absolutely  
as the said J. D. Shelly as Sheriff  
aforesaid and under the authority aforesaid  
right, could or might well and convey the

same. In testing my wheel I have hence
